

ArtsVote in Kansas

(Updated as of 7/7/24)



Ensure Your Vote is COUNTED on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 5, 2024

CONFIRM: Pre-Requisites

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Be at least 18 years of age by Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2024
- Be a resident of Kansas
- Not be currently serving a sentence for a felony conviction
- Not be claiming the right to vote in any other location or under any other name

STEP 1: Register to Vote & Check Accuracy

Check the Accuracy of your current voter registration. (NOTE: You MUST re-register each time you change your name, address, or party affiliation for voting.) To register to Vote for the first time, or to re-register, you can register online, inperson, or by mail. Your COMPLETED registration application must be RECEIVED by your County Election Office by Tuesday, October 15, 2024, (if mailed, it can be POSTMARKED). If you miss the deadline, you will NOT be able to vote during the 2024 General Election. Don't delay, pledge to check the accuracy of your voter status or register to vote by Tuesday, September 17, 2024.

STEP 2: Request Your Absentee Ballot (If Preferred)

In Kansas, voting by Advance Ballot **does not require an excuse**, but you must **apply** for it because it will **not** be sent to you automatically. You must request an **Advance Ballot** and return it by mail to your **County Election Office**. Your application must be RECEIVED by **Tuesday**, **October 29**, **2024**. Otherwise, you will have to physically vote in-person during Early Voting through Election Day. To track the status of your Advance Ballot, use Kansas' **Voter View**. **Don't delay**, **pledge to request your absentee ballot by Tuesday**, **October 8**, **2024**.

STEP 3: Cast Your Vote

ABSENTEE BALLOT: Cast your vote by mailing your completed and SIGNED Advance Ballot to your County Election Office so that it is POSTMARKED by Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2024 and RECEIVED by Friday, November 8, 2024. Don't delay, if you plan to vote absentee, pledge to mail in your completed Advance Ballot by Tuesday, October 23, 2024.

IN-PERSON VOTING: Cast your vote advance in-person at your <u>County Election Office</u> or satellite <u>Voting Location</u>. Early Voting begins on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>October 16</u>, <u>2024</u> through <u>Monday</u>, <u>November 4</u>, <u>2024</u> at <u>12:00 p.m. noon</u>. Voters are encouraged to contact their <u>County Election Office</u> to confirm advance voting dates and locations for their respective county. If you choose to vote in-person on <u>Election Day</u>, <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>November 5</u>, <u>2024</u>, polling hours take place between <u>7:00 a.m.</u> until <u>7:00 p.m.</u> at your <u>Polling Location</u>. NOTE: Some <u>Polling Locations</u> will open as early as <u>6:00 a.m.</u> and close as late as <u>8:00 p.m.</u> Always be sure to bring your government ID with you. <u>Don't delay</u>, <u>pledge to cast your vote in-person during advance voting and avoid the crowds</u>.

STEP 4: Celebrate Your Vote
